7. Demonstration of ***significant improvement*** in the provision of services to children.
8. ***Continuing outstanding effectiveness.***

If you have not already considered entering a nomination this year, the Awards Committee encourages you to assess all good things happening in your agency and submit your nomination. There are a lot of good ideas going on out there that people need to know about! Remember the more detail and originality you can provide, the more you stand out from the rest. 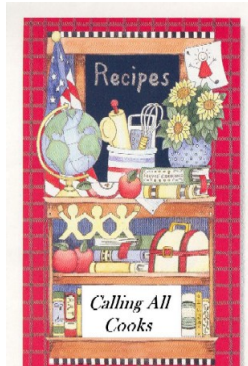

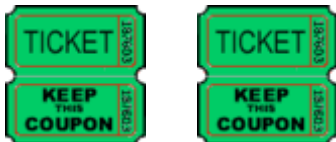

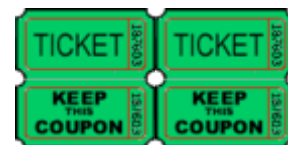
