- 1. Nominees must be notified and must agree to serve a three year term.**
- 2. Nominees must currently be a NCCSC member in good standing.**
- 3. Nominees must have approval from their supervisors and should be available to attend scheduled board meetings (usually held quarterly) in Raleigh.**
- 4. Nominations should be submitted by current NCCSC members in good standing.**
- 5. Nominations must include a brief biography of nominee and why the nominee would make a good board member. Please submit a picture of the nominee with the biography for the Conference Notebook.**

# County Banners





August 2008 NCCSC Conference is fast approaching. The County Banner Contest is up and running! Our theme, "You are a Star\*\*\*\*That's Just How Important You Are", will give your county the opportunity to "SHINE" and show off all the "STARS" that make up your office. Everyone will have the pleasure of seeing all the Banners at the conference during roll call and when each is displayed for Judging. A \$50.00 case prize will go the Overall County Winner this year so **Good Luck Stars!**

### Banner Criteria

The criteria for judging will be based on the following:

- a) Pre-Register: All banners **to be judged** must be pre-registered at the registration desk on Wed at 5 pm or Thursday by 9 am.
- b) Size: The banner cannot be larger than 30" by 36", whether it is vertical or horizontal.
- c) Theme: The banner must incorporate the 2008 theme:  
**"You are a Star\*\*\*\*That's Just How Important You Are!"**
- d) County Name: must be presented on the banner.
- e) The banner must be supported by vertical poles on each side. These poles must be minimum length of the banner, but not to exceed 5 feet tall. *(Necessary for Displaying and Judging)*

The banner must meet the **a-e criteria** to be considered further for judging.

Judges will use a 1-5 scale to rate the following:

- f) Overall Theme relation
- g) Creativity
- h) Artistic design
- i) Visual effect
- j) Professional appearance

### Winners will be selected as follows:

#### Trophy and Certificate

1<sup>st</sup> Place - Best Overall: Highest total score - All Categories & \$50.00 cash

2<sup>nd</sup> Place - Best Theme Related: Highest total score - Theme

3<sup>rd</sup> Place - Best Artistic Design: Highest total score - Artistic

HM - Best Overall: 2<sup>nd</sup> Highest total score - All Categories

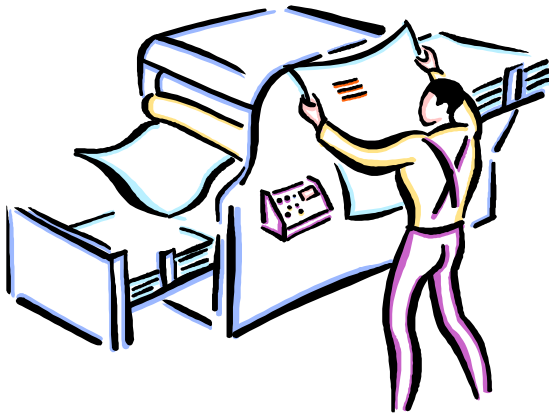

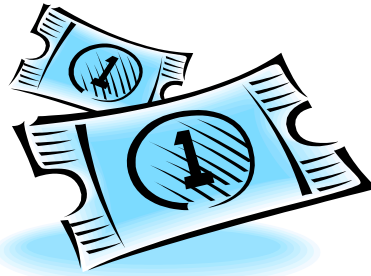
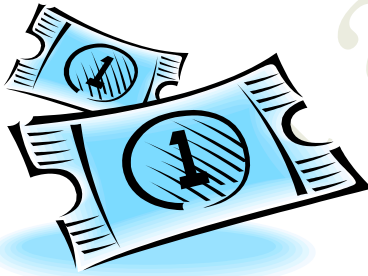
